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Vermont Food Venture Center

Vermont Food Venture Center's mission is to furnish all the necessary resources for entrepreneurs to start or grow a specialty food business. By assisting with the development of value-added products and providing ongoing technical assistance to the state's specialty food producers, the Center strengthens Vermont agriculture.

An annual membership fee entitles members to product development services which include: a half-day food safety and sanitation course; initial assistance with recipe, packaging, regulatory and label approval; marketing assistance; wholesale food and packaging services; and supplier and distributor information. The Center also provides expertise in research and development for new or existing products.

The Center is organized into three production areas (kitchen, bakery and packaging rooms), fully equipped with necessary utensils and stainless steel worktables. Dry, freezer and cooler storage areas are also available.
